NI IFMA Dues Update

We surveyed the chapter and asked questions about dues. Based on the responses, chapter members were in favor of raising the dues and making the meetings at no additional charge. The chapter has submitted paperwork to change our dues and our change has been approved by IFMA. Our fiscal year ends in June of 2017. Starting our new fiscal year, our chapter dues will go from \$92 to \$212. This is an increase of \$120 or the equivalent of 4 meetings. The advantage to this is that, when you renew, you will receive all the monthly meetings at no additional cost. This will not include our networking events or the holiday party. Until your renewal for the 2017-2018 fiscal year, you will still be charged the monthly fee of \$30 to attend. Once you have renewed under the new dues structure, your meetings will be free.
